Over the last few months, the project partners have hosted a series of training events and workshops to promote and share the resources of ADMIRE with professionals working in the field of adult education; migrant support workers and agencies; local development organisations and community groups. The events and seminars were used to present the new training resources developed, the digital toolbox of learning resources and the ADMIRE e-learning platform.

### Pilot testing - MIE Training Programme

The ADMIRE Migrant Integration Expert Curriculum has been designed to support the migrants to develop high quality integration strategies and activities that can help other migrants play a full and active role in civic and political life in their new host country. Each partner of the consortium has now pilot tested the Migrant Integration Expert Curriculum in their country, introducing migrants to 3 modules of the MIE Curriculum, getting their feedback and developing their skills.
